

**Options to Port Term Life and AD&D Insurance Coverage
For Employees of the State of Florida
*Underwritten by Minnesota Life Insurance Company***

What is portable coverage?

When you terminate your State employment, other than by retiring, you may continue your Optional Term Life and Accidental Death and Dismemberment (AD&D) insurance until age 70 at group rates. Minnesota Life will bill you directly. You must submit the election form within 31 days of employment termination.

Who is eligible for portable coverage?

All employees who are under age 70 may continue coverage otherwise lost due to termination of employment, layoff or loss of eligibility. You are not eligible to continue coverage if you were not actively at work due to sickness or injury on the day before you terminate employment or lose eligibility, or if the employer has canceled the group policy.

How much insurance can be continued?

You may continue all or a portion of your Optional Term Life and AD&D coverage currently in force, from a minimum of \$10,000 to a maximum of your full amount currently in force (65% of your full amount if 65 or older).

How do I make the portability election?

Complete the Portability Election form and send it to Minnesota Life within 31 days from the date the coverage would otherwise terminate.

Mail completed form to Minnesota Life Insurance Company. Send to our Tallahassee Branch Office or fax it.

Will I need to answer health questions?

No. All coverage is continued without proof of good health.

How long can I continue my insurance?

All ported insurance reduces by 35% at age 65 and ends at age 70.

How much will it cost?

Your monthly premium is based on age and coverage amount, and increases with age.

Age	Monthly Rate per \$1,000
Under 30	\$.144
30 - 34	\$.184
35 - 39	\$.206
40 - 44	\$.224
45 - 49	\$.310
50 - 54	\$.444
55 - 59	\$.670
60 - 64	\$1.226
65 - 69	\$1.866

Rates are subject to change

How do I calculate my monthly premium?

Divide the amount of insurance by 1,000. This is the number of units of insurance. Multiply the units of insurance by the rate listed for your age in the rate table. This is the monthly premium.

Example: A 49-year-old employee requests to continue \$150,000 of coverage.

\$150,000 ÷ 1,000	150	Units of insurance
	<u>x .310</u>	Monthly rate per unit for 49-year-old employee
	\$46.50	Monthly cost of employee's ported Term Life insurance

This sample employee's total monthly cost for porting \$150,000 of Optional Term Life is \$46.50.

What are my billing options?

Minnesota Life will bill you for the first premium payment after receiving your complete election form. Future premiums may be billed quarterly, semi-annually or annually. Or, you may elect monthly premium payments through Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) and you will not be billed; premiums will be deducted automatically from your checking account.

A \$2.00 fee is charged *per premium payment* for administrative fees, unless billed annually or EFT is being used.
